Are Over-the-Counter Hearing Aids Worth It?

I am often asked, "what about those hearing aids that are being sold over thecounter?"

It's important to note that these hearing aids are not the same as devices provided at audiology clinics and hearing centers. The FDA recently approved over-the-counter (OTC) hearing aids to increase access for those who want something basic; however, there is a big difference between OTC and prescription devices.

OTC hearing aids are a basic oction for those with mild to moderate hearing loss who are 18 years of age or older. OTC hearing aids cost between \$1,000 and \$2,000 and can be found online or at a pharmacy. They are a standard fit and have limited settings. A user must be comfortable setting the hearing aid up on their own using a smartphone and making their own adjustments.

Although OTC hearing aids may offer improved hearing without the expertise of an audiologist, there are some drawbacks. There is no guarantee it will meet your needs. Also, without a proper hearing test, you would not know if your hearing loss was caused by an underlying health condition.

Prescription hearing aids are an option for all ages and are only offered through audiology and hearing aid clinics. A hearing specialist assesses your condition and makes sure you will get the best results from your hearing device. The process includes a hearing test and a fitting by a professional. There are also more style choices and options for a proper and more comfortable fit.

Prescription devices also have the option of being controlled through a amartphone app. If you select a hearing aid that uses an app, you may be able to

have it adjusted by your hearing specialist remotely.

The cost difference between OTC and prescription hearing aids varies based on several factors. Although prescription hearing aids may cost more upfront, they come with a consultation and some insurance providers cover a portion of the cost. It's also important to consider long-term expenses such as batteries and how often the device will need to be replaced. OTC hearing aids may need to be replaced more often which may end up being more costly in the long run.

How do I know which option is right for me? Even if you are considering an OTC hearing aid, we recommend you have a professional hearing exam. We are happy to help you diagnose your hearing loss and compare hearing aid options so you can make an informed decision.

Hearing tests are recommended every two years starting at age 45, or sooner if you are at risk of hearing OSS.

- Preventative programs and education




